Rob's Tips & Tricks

The Peregrine Falcons returned to our building on May 3rd. There are only 2 pairs of these Falcons in Calgary and are on the endangered species list.

One pair nests at the University and the other pair on the TELUS building downtown. The TELUS pair uses our building as a base to hunt gophers, pigeons and mice. These are the two or three large birds you will see soaring over our area and the female is the largest. In the summer you will see three or four of them, the parents and usually two chicks. If you are lucky to see them dive, they can reach speeds of 300 kph.



The electronics recycling location north of 32nd Avenue that I mentioned previously has closed. Both Staples stores, the one on 32nd Avenue and the one by the old IKEA store accept electronics for recycling. There is a maximum of 5 items and there is no charge. Go through the front doors and head to the far right corner, bins are provided.
